


1) Go to <a href="https://hennepintech.edu">https://hennepintech.edu</a> and under Current Students, choose Eservices & Schedule.



2) At the bottom of page, under eServices, click on the campus you are attending.

eServices allows HTC students to register for classes, check grades, check financial and status, make populates and more.






3) Login with StarID and StarID password (wx1234yz – sample format).



4) Click on Financial Aid in the left navigation pane. A drop-down list will appear.



5) Click on Aid Application Status link. A possible version of the status may be similar to the screen below. Under Next Step, it may say that: You have not sent in your [year term] FAFSA results to Hennepin Technical College.



This status can occur for many different reasons:

- It takes anywhere from 5-7 days for the FAFSA to be received by the college.
   If you submitted the FAFSA within that day range, please wait for the process to complete. If it is after the processing period, you may contact fa@hennepintech.edu or onestop@hennepintech.edu for assistance.
- You may have completed a newer version of the FAFSA that what was intended (if completed after Oct 1).
   Skip to Step 6 to change semester in your FA Status. If no results, log into the FAFSA site (<a href="https://studentaid.gov">https://studentaid.gov</a>) to verify the FAFSA application year and check if complete.

- You did not enter the correct college code for Hennepin Technical College. The code is: 010491
- There could be an error on your FAFSA.
   Log into your FAFSA and confirm that your name, Date of Birth, and/or Social Security number are correct. If incorrect, make corrections and re-submit.
- 6) You may need to click on Change Semester to update to a previous or upcoming term. Select the correct term for the Financial Aid application and click Change Semester. You will see the note Semester successfully changed. Then click again on Aid Application Status in the left navigation pane.



7) The status page you see may look similar to the one shown below.

Financial Aid Status Semester: Spring 2022 Change semester Ready for Payment


8) This student's FAFSA has been received and the Aid Application Status is Complete. Under the Next Step section you can see that they have an award letter to review. Click on View Your Award Notification to see what the amount and what type of aid has been awarded.



9) You may also see how much of an award you are eligible for (see below). Grants and loans are both a part of Financial Aid. Grants are awarded based on credits registered. Loans are only eligible to students who are taking a minimum of 6 credits.



10) For more of a breakdown of your financial aid award by credit amount, click on Awards by credit level to see the amount of your awards at all credit levels.
