A new temporary testing site has opened near the State Capitol at the Minnesota Department of Transportation. The site provides nasal-swab PCR testing for all ages and is open daily from 7:00 am – 4:00 pm p.m. through February 14. The site is free and open to anyone. Staff will not collect any insurance information. Appointments are recommended. Walk-ins are welcomed.
