***ENGLISH PROFICIENCY REQUIREMENT**

Hennepin Technical College will accept one of the following options as proof as English Language proficiency:

- **Test of English Foreign Language (TOEFL)** www.toefl.org
- **Cambridge Michigan Language Assessment (CaMLA);** <http://cambridgemichigan.org>
- **An English Course** taken at a college or university in the United States of America with a passing grade of C or better
- **Accuplacer Placement Test:** If you are applying from inside the U.S., you can substitute Hennepin Tech's Accuplacer test for the TOEFL test. Student must test into college level reading and sentence skills to start classes at HTC.

| Test | Minimum Scores |
|----------------------|----------------|
| Paper-Based TOEFL | 500 |
| Internet-Based TOEFL | 61 |
| CaMLA | 75 |

NOTE: Students whose home country's official language is English are exempt from these requirements. Official English-speaking countries include:

Anguilla, Antigua and Barbuda, Australia, Bahamas, Barbados, Belize, Bermuda, Botswana, British Virgin Islands, Cameroon, Canada (except Quebec), Cayman Islands, Dominica, England, Fiji, Gambia, Ghana, Gibraltar, Grenada, Guyana, Ireland (Northern and Republic of), Jamaica, Kenya, Lesotho, Liberia, Malawi, Malta, Mauritius, Montserrat, Namibia, New Zealand, Nigeria, Papua New Guinea, Scotland, Seychelles, Sierra Leone, Singapore, Solomon Islands, South Africa, St. Kitts and Nevis, St. Lucia, St. Vincent and the Grenadines, Swaziland, Tanzania, Tonga, Trinidad and Tobago, Turks and Caicos Islands, Uganda, United Kingdom, United States, Vanuatu, Wales, Zambia, Zimbabwe.

***FINANCIAL REQUIREMENT**

You must submit a notarized, current, original bank statement showing a balance of at least **\$20,580** in U.S. currency to demonstrate adequate financial support to cover all educational and living expenses while you study at Hennepin Technical College.

If you have a sponsor, your sponsor must submit an **Affidavit of Support (I-134)** and a notarized, current, original bank statement showing a balance of at least **\$20,580** in U.S. currency. The bank statement must be in English, certified by a bank official, and not less than two (2) months old at the time of application.
