

The Federal Sexual Assault and Violence Prevention (SAVE) Act requires all students receive training about-sexual assault and violence prevention laws and more specifically, HTC policies and procedures. In compliance with Minnesota state law, all new students received this information during new student orientation.

Additionally, newly enrolled students are automatically enrolled in the Sexual Violence Prevention modules on D2L Brightspace. To access the training, log into D2L Brightspace and click the *Sexual Violence Prevention Training* (SVPT) module. Please take the time to complete the training so you are knowledgeable about the law, policies, and procedures that continue to make HTC a welcoming and safe place for all. If you have completed this training at another Minnesota State institution, you may disregard the training modules.
