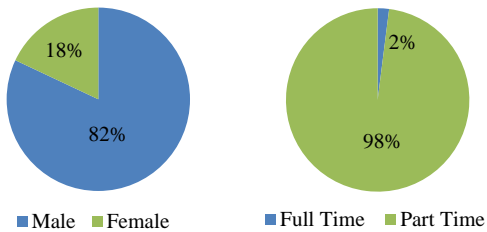

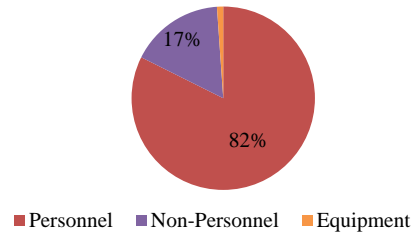

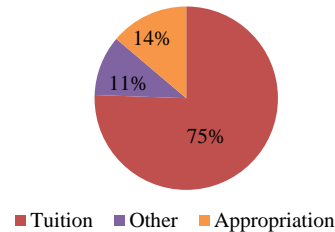

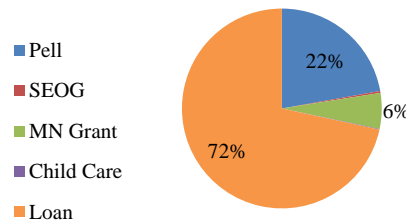
## Expenditures
