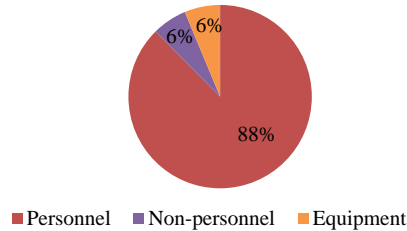

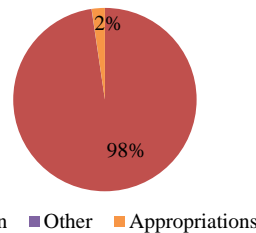

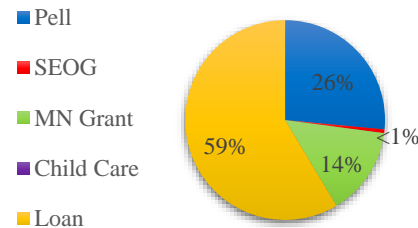
Expenditures
