# Background: Gathering

Starts with Bangs and Ends with Gizzards from Original Local by Heid Erdrich

"When we gather as a family, we cook. Our annual big family get together is a tremendous feast and a feat of indigenous cooking: Mom makes at least one turkey with manoomin-corn bread stuffing and, to skip ahead to dessert, Juneberry pie, and cherry pie from our parents' own tree, as well as Secret Ingredient Pumpkin Pie..."

"Remarkably, our family feasts include vegetarians, people who stay dairy free or gluten free, and others with requirements of a diabetic diet—all satisfied by our offerings. Perhaps that's why our dishes have grown so varied—many needs, and equally diverse opportunities (the luck of hunters, a good squash crop) means much to share."

"And we have always gathered our food as well. What is called foraging to us was just getting food. To many Native people living in the Upper Midwest, gathering remains an important part of eating right, protected by treaty rights."

"Our big family visits and the feasts involved require the expertise of our sister Dr. Angie Erdrich... Angie e-mails a list each year to help us remember what to bring to our family feast. Last year the list snowballed to over one hundred items and contained requests for an enormous variety of goods from the usual to the specific to the mysterious, and grew more eccentric as we e-mailed back and forth... Still, everything you need to know about our family feast is revealed in the first and last items on a list that starts with "bangs" and ends with "gizzards."
